1. I submit that I am presently working as Joint Director (Services) in the O/o. the Commissioner and Director of School Education, Andhra Pradesh, Hyderabad and as such, I am well acquainted with the facts of the case. I am filing this affidavit on behalf of the petitioners as I am authorized to do so.

2. I submit that this Writ Petition is filed questioning the legality and validity of the orders of the Hon'ble Tribunal dated.21.09.2011 in O.A.Nos. 3492/2011 directing the respondents to notify all the vacancies of Panel Grade Head Masters / Gr.II Gazetted Head Masters which were filled from September 2009 to April 2011 as was done earlier in the general transfer counseling held in July 2009 by holding that the action of the respondents in not notifying the vacancies held by the juniors to the applicants in transfer counseling as illegal, arbitrary and discriminatory and violative of Article 14 & 16 of Constitution of India by dismissing the OAs filed by the 2nd set of applicants.

3. I submit that the respondent applicants along with similarly placed persons in other districts filed OAs before the Hon'ble Andhra Pradesh Administrative Tribunal praying that during the transfer counseling held as per G.O.Ms.No.65, dated.19.05.2011, all the vacancies of Head Master Gr.II Gazetted were not notified by keeping the posts held by some of the promotees promoted during the September 2009 to April 2011 who were juniors were retained in their better places on promotion without notifying them for transfer counseling as illegal and prayed the Hon'ble Tribunal to direct the respondents to notify such vacancies filled between September 2009 to April 2011 for transfer counseling held as per G.O.Ms.No.65, dated.19.05.2011 as they have lost the chances of getting category I / Category II places which have 20% and more admissible HRA.

4. I submit that Government notified vide G.O.Ms.No.15, Edn., dated 26.01.2009, "Andhra Pradesh Teachers General Promotions and Regulations of Transfer Rules" These rules regulate counseling for promotion in the cadres of Head Master Gazetted Gr.II and School Assistants from the feeder categories and also to take up general transfer counseling of teachers under "Andhra Pradesh School Education Service Rules" and "Andhra Pradesh School Education Subordinate Service Rules" working in the Government Schools and ZPP/MPP Schools. The promotions and transfers were made during the promotion and transfer counseling of teachers in a transparent way by

constituting District Promotion and Transfer Counseling Committees. The promotions accorded during the said period were on adhoc basis and the teachers so promoted were directed to take over the charge in the promotion post immediately and get relief and join in the old station to take up teaching for the pupil till the end of the academic year. At the end of the academic year, the transfer counseling was held and all the vacancies including the vacancies held by the promotee teachers were taken up for the transfer counseling. Thus the transfer counseling was conducted in a transparent manner and all the teachers joined in their respective postings without any complaint.

5. I submit that Government have taken a decision to fill up the vacancies month-wise arising consequent on retirements of teachers from the feeder categories by promotion through the respective District Promotion Committees. Accordingly some of the teachers were promoted as Head Masters / School Assistants during the monthly promotion counselings and posted in the vacancies available at the time of counseling. This is a general procedure being followed in every department in the State Government service. Every year, the State Government is imposing ban on transfers and the said ban is relaxed during the closure of the academic year for enabling the departments to affect transfers to suit the administration. There is no ban on according promotions and filling up of the vacant post in Government service.

6. I submit that Government notified vide G.O.Ms.No.65, Education Department, dated.19.05.2011 "Andhra Pradesh Teachers (Regulation of Transfer) Rules in supersession of all earlier notifications and guidelines on transfer of teachers. These guidelines are applicable for affecting transfers in categories of Head Masters Gazetted Gr.II, School Assistants & Secondary Grade Teachers and their equivalent categories in the Andhra Pradesh Educational Service Rules and Andhra Pradesh School Education Subordinate Service Rules working in the Government Schools and ZPP and MPP Schools in the State. Rule 5, 6, 17,18, 19, 20, 21, 22 & 23 of the said rules read as under:

(c) The teachers / HMs who are to be compulsorily transferred and who do not attend for counseling, shall be given posting orders absentia to the left over vacancies at the end of the counseling of that particular category of teachers, in the presence of Committee and in the counseling hall without fail.

21. Review

Once transfer orders are issued by the competent authority with the approval of the Committee, review or modification of orders shall not be considered, either by the Committee or by the Competent authority. The person should join in the place of posting. Avoiding of posting orders and applying for treatment of waiting period as compulsory wait will not be entertained under any circumstances

22. Appeal

(a) An appeal against the orders of the DEO shall lie with the R JDSE concerned, and an appeal against the orders of the RJDSE shall lie with the C&DSE. Such appeal should be submitted within 10 days.

(b) All such appeals shall be disposed off by the Appellate authorities concerned within 30 days from the date of receipt of the appeal.

23. Powers of the Commissioner and Director of School Education

(a) The Commissioner and Director of School Education may either suo-moto or on an application received from any person aggrieved by the orders of the Transfer Committee may call for and examine the records in respect of any proceedings of transfer to satisfy himself about the regularity, legality or propriety. If, in any case, it appears to him that any such proceedings should be modified, annulled or reversed or remitted for reconsideration, he may pass orders accordingly or remand the case with any direction so as to rectify any violation of rules or discrepancy. Such orders shall be implemented by the authority concerned.

(b) The Commissioner & Director of School Education may stay the implementation of any such proceedings, pending exercise of its powers under sub-rule (1) above."

7. I submit that according to Rule No.6 of the above rules, Head Master (Grade -II gazetted and teachers who have completed two years of service in a place/school as on 1st June of the year are eligible to apply for transfer. It is only a discretion to apply and there is no mandate compelling all the teachers who have completed two years of service. Rule NO.5 of the rules mandate compulsory transfer of a teacher who has completed 8 years of service in a school or locality. I further submit that on the representation of Headmasters Grade-II Gazetted who were promoted in September, 2009, the condition of completing two years of service as on 1st June, 2011 is relaxed by amending the provision in Rule

No.6 and incorporating note, the notification of which was published vide G.O.Ms.No.66, Education Department, dated 25.05.2011.

8. I submit that the transfer counseling interims of G.O.Ms.No.65, Edn., dated.19.05.2011 was conducted in a transparent manner duly preparing the seniority list of the eligible candidates for transfer and notifying the vacancies available as on that date through internet. Based on the consent given by the candidates with the recommendation of the District Transferring Counseling Committee, transfers were affected. All the respondent applicants given their consent / opting place of postings before the District Transfer Committee and based on the recommendation of the committee only, they were given transfer orders and the respondent applicants complied with the postings and joined in the places.

9. I respectfully submit that batch of O.As are filed in the Hon'ble Tribunal seeking a direction that the vacancies filled up by promotion in the Head Master Grade-II Gazetted category from August, 2009 should also be displayed as vacancies. The Hon'ble Tribunal passed interim orders dated 02.06.2011 in O.A.No.3447 of 2011 and batch directing to notify all the vacancies of PG Headmasters / Gr.II Headmasters (Gazetted) who are promoted from September, 2009 to April, 2011. Another batch of O.As are filed by Headmasters Grade-II gazetted who were promoted after August, 2009 claiming that they should not be subjected to transfer counseling. The Hon'ble Tribunal passed interim orders on 07.06.2011 in O.A. NO.4321 of 2011 directing the respondents to continue the applicants in their present place of work as they are not entitled to participate in the transfer counseling and thus are not liable to be disturbed. Both sets of O.As were heard together and disposed of by common order dated 21.09.2011. The Hon'ble Tribunal directed to include all the vacancies filled from September, 2009 to April, 2011 in the counseling for transfers and give opportunity to all the candidates to opt places of their choice. Thus the Hon'ble Tribunal has allowed first set of O.As. and dismissed the second set of O.As.

10. I submit that the order of the Hon'ble Tribunal is contrary to the law and facts of the case.

11. The Hon'ble Tribunal failed to appreciate that there is general ban on transfers now. The ban will be lifted in June-July, 2012.

12. The Hon'ble Tribunal failed to appreciate that the Rules notified in G.O.Ms.No.65, Edn., dated.19.05.2011 do not provide any stipulation for submission of applications by the teachers who were promoted from September, 2010 onwards for participation in transfer counseling as they have not completed two years of stay at the present station. As they have not completed 8 years of service, they cannot be subjected to compulsory transfer.

13. The Hon'ble Tribunal failed to appreciate that transfer of employees is an incident of service and the Hon'ble Supreme Court repeatedly emphasized that the courts or Tribunals should not interfere with transfer orders unless such transfer orders are issued due to mala fides or in contravention of statutory rules. The Government conducted the transfer counseling on a transparent manner by constituting District Transferring Committee to recommend the transfers and postings based on the willingness given by the teachers. Thus, there is no mala fide intension or contravention of statutory rules in effecting the transfers in the transfer counseling and therefore the interference of the Hon'ble Tribunal is against the settled Principles of law.

14. The Hon'ble Tribunal failed to appreciate that there is heavy burden on the State Government if the orders of the Hon'ble Tribunal are implemented by a way of TA and DA and there is dislocation of teaching to the pupil in the middle of the academic year.

15. The Hon'ble Tribunal failed to appreciate that transfers should not be made during the middle of the academic year as it will disturb the teaching programme and students would suffer. Thus it is not in public interest to effect transfer of Headmasters at this stage.

16. I submit that the Hon'ble Tribunal has not appreciated that there is no right vested in the respondents to seek for transfer of other Head Masters and to subject them to transfer counseling. The claim of the applicants before the Hon'ble Tribunal is that juniors to them are occupying better places of posting. The said contention is made on the premise as if they have a vested right to seek posting of their choice.

17. The Hon'ble Tribunal has not appreciated that the provisions in Rule No.5 and 6 are not under challenge and in view of the said provisions, no Headmaster who has not completed 8 years of service cannot be compelled to transfer.

18. The Hon'ble Tribunal has not appreciated that house rent allowance cannot be claimed as a matter of right. Based on the prevailing rental values in various stations, various stations are categorized and house rent allowance is determined. Based on the place of posting, employee gets the house rent allowance as long as he works in that place. The Primary contention of the applicants in the O.As is based on the wrong assumption that they have right to insist for place of posting because that place has more house rent allowance.

19. The reasoning assigned by the Hon'ble Tribunal para in No.26 of the decision is based on equitable exercise of jurisdiction whereas such jurisdiction is not vested in the Hon'ble Tribunal more particularly when the subject matter of the O.As is covered by statutory provisions.

20. I submit that the present orders will completely reverse the exercise already completed long back and it is not advisable to undo entire thing at this stage of the academic year

21. I submit that other grounds will be urged at the time of hearing with the leave of this Hon'ble Court.

25. It is further prayed that this Hon'ble Court in the interest of justice be pleased to suspend the operation of the orders dated. 21.09.2011 in O.A.No 3492/2011, the file of the Hon'ble Andhra Pradesh Administrative Tribunal, Hyderabad pending disposal of the Writ Petition and pass such other order or orders as this Hon'ble High Court may deem fit and proper in the circumstances of the case.
